After coin toss:

Return to far sideline and meet with Box Operator

Then introduce myself to the assistant coaches

On 4th down, I'll communicate with coaches for their options

Inside of two minutes, I let coaches know of their time out situation, and will remind them each time one is taken



Sideline Management



• Key Points

- Safety for both coaches & officials
 - Allow coaches to communicate between downs
 - Coaches need to be in the Team Box during play
 - Keep in mind game situation and awareness
 - Get back coach???

- Unlike in football, the restricted area box extends between the 20 yard lines

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Sideline Management

- **Fouls:**
 - **Coaches outside Team box 9-8-3 (Situational Awareness)**
 - **1st - Sideline Warning**
 - **2nd - 5-yard Penalty**
 - **3rd – 10-yard USC and 1st down if by the defense**
 - **4th – 10-yard USC, 1st down if by the defense, & DQ of Head Coach**
 - **Sideline Interference: Illegal Personal Contact with a coach 9-4-5**
 - **1st - 10-yard Personal Foul and 1st down if by the defense**
 - **2nd - 10-yard Personal Foul, 1st down if by the defense, DQ of Head Coach**
